FACILITIES

This means no transporting campers from one site to another, no long walks across campus, no outdoor sessions and more time for instruction and skill development.. LOCATION

UWSP is located in the heart of Wisconsin, accounting for many outstanding campers that attend from all regions of the state. Located along the scenic Wisconsin River, U.S. Highway 51/Interstate 39 provides easy four lane access to the city of Stevens Point. UWSP is 70 miles from the Fox Valley, 90 miles from Green Bay/Madison, 110 Miles from Eau Claire/La Crosse and 150 miles from Milwaukee.

ROOM/BOARD

Resident Campers will be housed two to a room in a modern and convenient residence hall on the UWSP campus one block from the athletic facilities. Campers receive constant supervision as counselors and coaches room on the same floors. Meals will be served in the residence dining center, which is also within easy walking distance of the residence halls and gyms. Some meals will be arranged at off-campus restaurants.

REFUND/DEPOSIT

A \$100 deposit must accompany all applications for overnight camps. Cancellations made prior to June 1 will be refunded the deposited amount less a \$50 administrative fee. After June 1, refunds (less a \$50 administrative fee) will be made for special circumstances only.

COMMUTERS

Commuters are campers who elect not to stay in the residence hall. Commuters do not eat breakfast on campus but will be provided lunch and dinner. Parking Permits are available through parking services at \$3.50/day. You can reach parking services at 715-346-3900.

HEALTH HISTORY

It is required that all campers complete and have on file a UWSP Camp Health History Form. The health history form will be sent to you with your confirmation letter. Return the form to us as soon as possible. If we do not have the form on file, we cannot permit the camper to participate in the volleyball camp. Also in the confirmation letter there will be further information regarding all details of the camp.

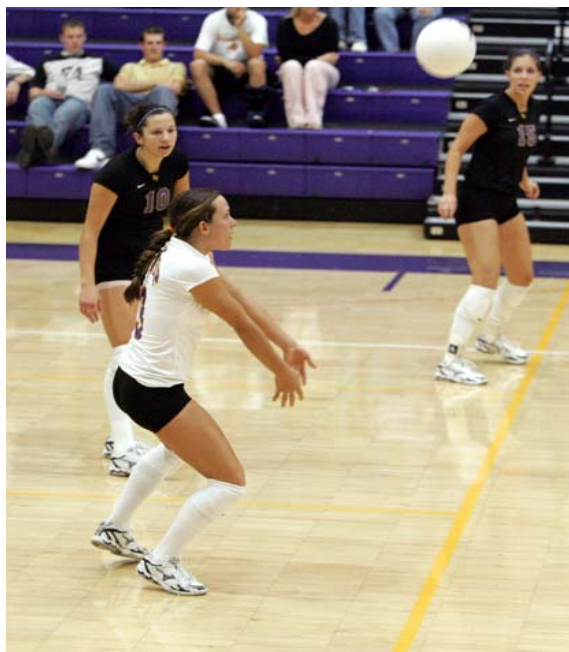
CAMP INSTRUCTORS
